K-8 Early Registration for 2017/2018 is open now until March 15.
NEW → Registration forms must be filled out electronically. They are attached to today's newsletter again. If you are having trouble with the form, they're also available on the website – www.crownoflifemn.org. Go to School, then Registration. Follow the instructions on the form. The registration fee is \$500 per child, and will be applied to your family's tuition amount. The fee must be received by March 15.

After March 15, the registration fee will be \$550 per child, with only \$500 per child applying to your family's account. New families are charged \$500 per child.

PreK families are invited to register at any time.

Daylight Savings Time resumes this weekend – Turn your clocks AHEAD 1 hour on Saturday night!


