TRACK: Congratulations to our COL track team for taking second place in the Lutheran Grade School Track Meet last Friday held at St. Croix. There was great competition, great results and great weather!

There have been many changes and adjustments made to the track schedule, due to weather, since it first came out the start of the season. The COL online calendar has been updated to reflect those changes. You can also view the schedule using the St. Croix Middle School online track calendar.

Today, the track team will compete in the Brooklyn Center Track Meet (Address: 6500 Humboldt Ave N, Minneapolis, MN 55430). The meet starts at 4:15 and will conclude around 6 pm. The COL track athletes will be picked up by a St. Croix bus at COL around 2:35 and transported to the meet.
