**VOLLEYBALL:** Congratulations to both of our volleyball teams. They competed in the West LHS Volleyball Tournament this past Sunday where both teams brought home the championship trophy! Yesterday, both teams traveled to Salem, Stillwater for League games. The COL A and B teams won both their games in two. Way to go Raiders!

Tomorrow, COL will host Trinity, Belle Plaine here at COL. The game times will be pushed back a bit to give Belle Plaine enough travel time. The B Team girls will play first at 4:30 and the A Team girls will play second, around 5:15. A short study hall will be provided for the B Girls Team so they won't have to go home and turn right around to come back to school. We ask that A Team players get picked up in carline as usual since their game isn't until later in the evening.

After tomorrow's game, there is just one more regular season game for both teams. Next week, King of Grace will travel to COL to play. Game times are switched to accommodate the KOG teams.
