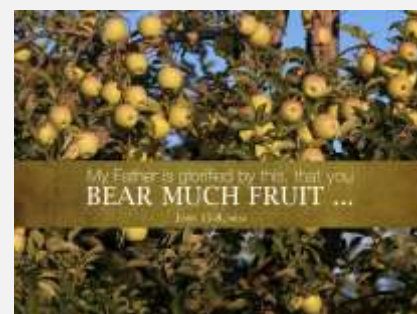

VOLLEYBALL: Congratulations to our "A" girls volleyball team for winning last Saturday's Dig-It Tournament held in Shakopee. This makes it three years in a row that Crown of Life has taken home the first place trophy! Our "B" team also did a great job competing in their round robin style play at the tournament; winning more games than they lost. The girls "A" team hosted Berea yesterday with Berea taking the first game, but COL coming back to win the next 2, thus winning the match. Tomorrow both teams will travel to Belle Plaine to compete against Trinity. The games times are pushed back a little because Pilgrim's "A" team will be playing against Trinity at 4 pm. Our "B" girls will play next (around 4:45ish), followed by our "A" team (around 5:30ish). Players (and siblings) can be picked up at normal release time in the **West parking lot** tomorrow; directions will be given to the players.

This Sunday both the "A" and "B" teams will be representing COL at a volleyball tournament at West Lutheran.
