Track: This past Friday COL competed in their annual Lutheran Grade School Track Meet held at St. Croix. It was great weather and great competition! Here is a list of the number of ribbons won by our athletes in their individual events: 6th place: 11, 5th place: 9, 4th place: 14, 3rd place: 10, 2nd place: 10 and 1st place: 4. For the relay teams; COL had 1 fifth place finish, and 2 first place finishes. Those results put COL in second place overall with 292 points, just surpassing King of Grace with 260 and Good Shepherd with 231. Congratulations to our track athletes. Thank you to our coaches, Mr. and Mrs. Plath, for their support and enthusiasm.

Bowling: The COL bowling team is wrapping up their season with a few more practices leading up to the end of the year League tournament on Friday, May 20, held at Midway Pro-Bowl (1556 University Ave W, St Paul, MN 55104) beginning at 4:30. Please be there as soon as possible in order to start the matches on time. Bowlers should plan to leave right after school. Bowlers and their siblings will be released out the West side parking lot in order to be picked up as soon as possible after school (normal release time). Here is a quick write up by Coach Swiderski about our bowling team's regular season finish: *The Crown of Life Bowling Teams finished their regular season with huge excitement. The Crown of Life A-1 team captured the season championship with a 7-1 record. In an extremely tight match against St. John, Crown of Life pulled out a win in the 5th game by 1 pin (109-108) to claim victory for the match and the League Championship. Crown of Life A-2 finished a very respectable 5th place at 6-2 (there were 5 teams at 6-2). Crown of Life A-2 helped A1 out by defeating Good Shepherd in a huge upset - moving Good Shepherd into 4th when they would have been in 1st Place. The Crown of Life B-Team finished in style achieving their High Game (114) and High 5-Game series (443) during their last match of the regular season.*
