Cross Country: Good luck to our Cross Country runners as they compete in their meet today. The race is held at Maple Heights Park in Maplewood (2078 Beam Ave. right by the Maplewood Mall). Directions and jerseys will be handed out to the runners as they leave school today. Parking is very limited in the park; most will need to park on Beam Ave. After the race is finished, please return your uniform to Coach Kruse.

Preseason Basketball Parent Meeting: There will be a basketball meeting for all parents of COL basketball players next **Thursday, Oct. 26 @ 7 pm** in the fellowship hall. At the meeting we will be go through the practice/game schedule for the year, discuss the rule changes for this season and any special notes concerning other schools/teams. There will also be a sign up sheet for duties such as concessions and other various jobs during our home games. Parents/players from all four basketball teams should plan to attend this one-time meeting.

A **study hall** for those teams with the **Late Practice** will be provided before practice on the respective days.
