Crown of Life opened their basketball season with away games played at Salem, Stillwater against Christ Lutheran last Friday evening. The Girls B started off the night with a win and the Boys A ended the night with a win for the Raiders. The scores were: Girls B (24-18), Boys B (17-28), Girls A (11-17) and Boys A (32-28).

COL will host their first home games of the season this Friday. Two schools will be traveling to COL to take on the Raiders. Game times will be bit different than usual. The Girls A team will play first against Cross of Christ beginning at 4:30. The Girls B team will follow, playing against Mt. Olive at 5:30. Then the Boys B will play at 6:30 against Mt. Olive, and finally the Boys A will end the night's games against Mt. Olive at 7:30. The **Cheerleaders** will cheer for the first two games of the evening (4:30 and 5:30).

With the earlier start time for the games on Friday, the Girls A team and the Cheerleaders will be allowed to stay at school after dismissal (if they wish). The basketball players will meet in Mr. Noack's classroom and the cheerleaders will meet in Ms. VanCalster's room. All other players should be picked up in carline as usual. For safety and security reasons we ask that no children be left at school unsupervised. Please make arrangements with after school care if your child needs to stay after school and isn't either a Girls A basketball player or cheerleader. Thank you.
