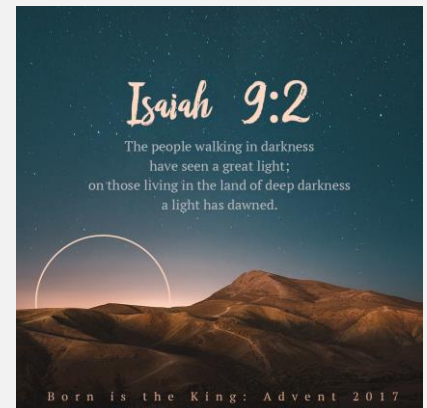

Last week Crown of Life's A Teams traveled to Salem, Stillwater to compete in League games. That night the Girls A Team picked up their first win by defeating Salem, 35-11.
