Please follow the instructions given with the form. The registration fee is \$500 per child, and is due with your form. This is a non-refundable deposit toward your tuition. *After March 15, the registration fee for currently enrolled families will be \$550, with only \$500 per child applying to your tuition. New families are charged \$500 per child.*
