Today is the last day for K-8 Early Registration!

NEW → Registration forms must be filled out electronically. They are attached to today's newsletter again. If you are having trouble with the form, they're also available on the website – www.crownoflifemn.org. Go to School, then Registration. Follow the instructions on the form. The registration fee is \$500 per child, and will be applied to your family's tuition amount. The fee must be received by 3:00 today.

After today, the registration fee will be \$550 per child, with only \$500 per child applying to your family's account. New families are charged \$500 per child.

Please notify the office if your child will NOT be returning to COL.

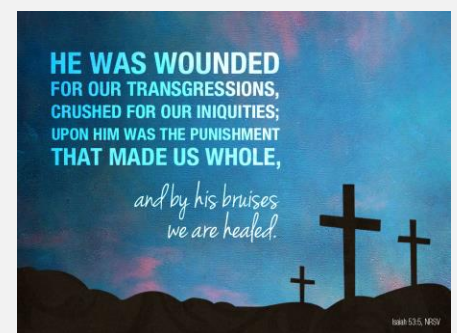

Track: Crown of Life will be expanding the track season this year, going from one track meet to four. We will also have the opportunity to practice on an actual track. COL and the Middle School are working together to provide the best opportunity for our athletes by competing in multiple track meets and utilizing St. Croix's track facility for practices. Track practice begins Tuesday, April 4 from 3:30 – 5:00 and will be held at St. Croix. Transportation to the track for practices will be provided by St. Croix. Parents can pick up their child at St. Croix after practice concludes at 5:00. Most practices will be held on Mondays with a few on Tuesdays and Thursdays (at the beginning of the season) and one on Wednesday (towards the end of the season). All meets are held on Thursdays with the exception of the Lutheran Metro Meet held on Friday, May 4. A track schedule will be handed out on Friday and will also be available online in the coming days. We are excited to offer a more complete track schedule to our athletes this year.

Bowling: The bowling schedule is set and will be handed out Friday to those who wish to bowl for Crown of Life this season. It will also be available online in the coming days. A bowling sign-up sheet is available in the lunch room. If your child plans on bowling, please remind them to write their name down on the sheet so we can have an accurate count of how many teams COL will have this year. Practices will be every Tuesday and Wednesday from 3:30-5:00 at Concord Lanes (formerly Matties) in South St. Paul. Parents are responsible for transporting their child to and from practices at the bowling alley.
