Show your Facebook page to April to receive tuition credit for the 2016/17 school year. *Limit 2 parent Facebook accounts.*

All accounts must be current as of May 31. This includes your SMART Tuition account, lunch account and library accounts. Make sure all library items are returned, and fines paid. **Report cards are held for outstanding tuition balances, lunch account balances, library materials or fines.** (This does not include families that are on a 10 or 11 month tuition payment plan.)

Lost & Found – Please check the Lost & Found rack near the gym doors. Any unclaimed items will be donated to the Thrift Store after the last day of school. There are a lot of jackets, gloves etc.

Tuition Assistance Applications are available through the office or online. Return your application and all accompanying paperwork to the office, in a sealed envelope, **by June 15.**

We are still registering for next school year.

There is a \$550 per child non-refundable registration fee due with your family's form. This fee is a deposit toward your family's tuition.

Please download your form, fill out, then SAVE IT under your family name before sending it back. Hard copies are also available from the school office. **Please let Mr. Plath or April know if your child/ren will NOT be returning to Crown of Life.***

Pre-K Registration: Registration packets are available on our website. An \$80 non-refundable registration fee is due with your registration form. Registration forms are available from the office, or Mrs. Johnson, the Pre-K teacher. Please register by June 15 if possible. Mrs. Amber Johnson will teach all classes.

Report Cards will be available for pick-up from the office on Tuesday, June 7.
