We are now taking registrations for next school year. Register online with our form found on our website, under School/Forms. Please follow the instructions given with the form. The registration fee is \$500 per child, and is due by March 15. This is a non-refundable deposit toward your tuition. *After March 15, the registration fee for currently enrolled families will be \$550, with only \$500 per child applying to your tuition. New families are charged \$500 per child.*

Tuition Assistance – If your family is in need of Tuition Assistance for next school year, you will find applications on the website. The application period is April 15 – June 15.

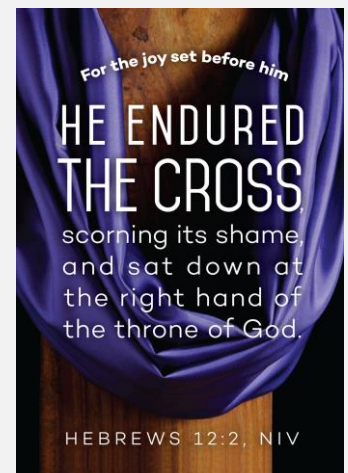

Track: For the second year COL will co-op with the Middle School to form one track team.
