If you have not yet registered your child for next year, please do so soon. Register online with our form found on our website, under School/Forms. **Follow the instructions given with the form, and email the form to the office.** The registration fee is now \$550 per child, and is due with your form. This is a non-refundable deposit toward your tuition; \$500 per child will apply to your family's tuition. *New families are charged \$500 per child. Please contact us if you know your child will not be returning to COL.*

TRACK: The fourth graders got their first taste of track yesterday as they began their practices. They will join with the regular track team next week Tuesday and Wednesday with practices held at St. Croix both days from 3:30 – 5:00. A bus from St. Croix will come to COL to pick up the track athletes. Students should bring all their bags, backpacks, etc. with them as they leave COL and parents are to pick up their child from St. Croix after practice.

Tomorrow is the first track meet of the season. This meet is only for grades 5-8. There is a change from the original track schedule that needs to be noted. Tomorrow's track meet will be held at Fridley High School (not Brooklyn Center). The address of the Fridley track is: 6000 W Moore Lake Dr NE, Minneapolis, MN 55432. Track athletes will be picked up from COL by a St. Croix bus at 3:10 and transported to the track meet. If you would rather drive your child to the track meet you can pick them up after school at COL. The bus will not bring students back, please plan on picking your child up from the track meet when it is finished (typically between 7:30 – 8:00).
