TRACK: Congratulations to our COL track team for taking second place in the Lutheran Grade School Track Meet last Friday held at St. Croix. There was great competition, great results and great weather!

There has been a change in location for this Thursday's track meet. The printed sports calendar shows a meet at Fridley, which was changed a while ago to be run at Brooklyn Center. Just recently it was changed a third time. **It will now be run at Columbia Heights High School (address: 1400 49th Ave NE, Columbia Heights, MN 55421). Please make note of the new location. The meet will start around 4:15.**

There will be **NO BUS TRANSPORTATION** provided by St. Croix for tomorrow's meet. All Crown of Life athletes will need to arrange their own transportation to and from the track meet. Students will be released from school as normal and can be picked up in carline. The final track meet of the season will be next Thursday, May 17. This is the Conference Championship and it will be held at St. Croix starting at 4:15. This meet will not be for all athletes, instead, only the top 2 competitors from each event can be entered.

BOWLING: The bowling team competed in their make-up meet from April last night at AMF Lanes. They have a short break of a few days and then are back at it with their next meet on Saturday, May 12 at New Hope Bowl in Minneapolis (address: 7107 42nd Ave N, Minneapolis, MN 55427). This will be the final regular season meet before the League Bowling Tournament next Saturday (May 19).
