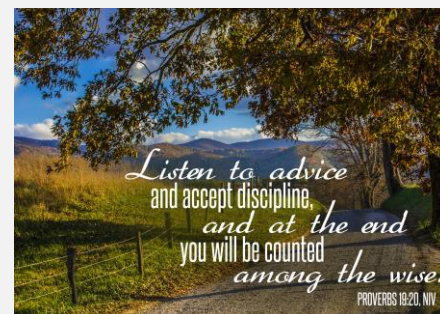

There will be a practice this Friday from 3:15 - 4:30 at the disc golf course by Garlough (just north of COL) for those who plan to attend this Saturday's disc golf meet.
