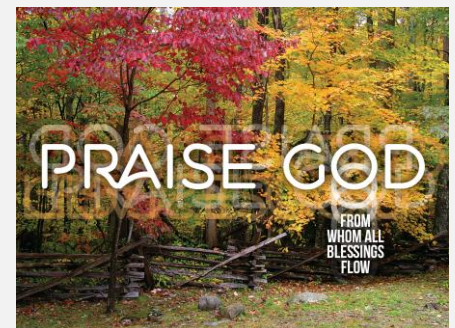

Raider Retreat

"Raider Retreat" is the name selected by 7-8th grade students and approved by a faculty committee for the room formerly known as the Computer Lab. The room is located on the second floor next to the library and will be used by students as a work/study room, an area for group projects, and hopefully, multi-media presentations.

Designed by Jessica Kelm, it will feature relaxed seating furniture, conference table and chairs, high top table and chairs, and green screen capabilities. The project can be done in three phases with the relaxed seating deemed the first phase.

The approximate cost for the project is \$10,000. The \$1422 "Penny Wars" collection from 2017-18 has been designated for Raider Retreat as well as PTN fundraising efforts this year. Volleyball: The volleyball teams look to keep their perfect match record going against the CAA teams as they host St. Joseph in volleyball action today at Crown of Life. The A team plays first at 4 pm with the B team to follow around 4:45 pm.

Tomorrow there will be **no practice** for the B Team while the A team takes the gym to prepare for their end of the season tournament for the WELS League happening Friday. The A team will practice right after school from 3:15-4:30. Tournament information for this Friday's A Team Tournament will be sent home today. It can also be found on the Team App under documents. Pool play starts at 4pm at St. Croix. Players and siblings can be picked up in the West Parking Lot on Friday.

Next Monday both teams officially end the volleyball season with one final CAA game against Community of Saints. This will be a home game for both teams with the A team starting at 4pm and the B team around 4:45pm.

Soccer: Thank you to Coach Pudlo and Coach Noack for coaching our soccer team this season! All soccer jerseys should be washed and returned to Mr. Ohm by Friday.

Cross Country: This past Saturday was a first for the Cross Country program. COL's 3rd and 4th graders ran in their first cross country meet held at St. Croix. All of the runners from COL turned out great times, many of them were personal bests. As a team, COL brought home the most ribbons/medals of any of the schools who competed at the meet. The ribbon/medal count for COL was: 4th place: 1, 3rd place: 2, 2nd place: 5, 1st place: 3 (6 of them were won by our 3rd and 4th graders). Way to go runners!

There are just two practices left before the cross country meet next Wednesday, Oct. 17. The meet will begin at 1:00pm and will be run at Bassett Creek Park (5609 32nd Ave N, Crystal, MN 55422). This meet is for grades 5-8 only. Runners (and their siblings) can be picked up in the West Parking Lot at 11:30. Uniforms will be given to the runners as they leave school next Wednesday.

Disc Golf: There will one final disc golf practice this Friday (3:15-4:30) right after school at Garlough Park. Plan to pick up your child in the West Parking Lot and meet on the sidewalk at Garlough. The final disc golf meet of the season will be held this Saturday at Bassett Creek Park (address: 6001 32nd Ave N, Crystal, MN 55422). Be there by 9:00am for a course orientation meeting; shotgun start at 9:30am. This course is notorious for being wet. Plan to wear shoes/boots that can accommodate for wet conditions.
