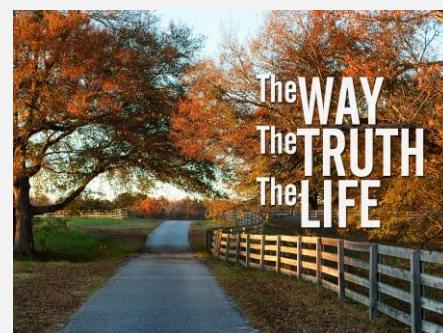

At the meeting we will go through the practice/game schedule for the season, discuss any rule changes for this season and any special notes concerning other schools/teams. There will also be a sign up sheet for duties such as concessions and other various jobs during our home games. Parents from all four basketball teams should plan to attend this one-time meeting.
