Christian Calendars available for sale from PTN, on the table outside the office. Cost is \$7.00 each.

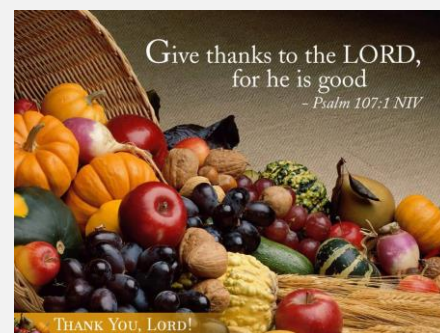
