


Cheerleading: There is cheerleading practice today from 3:15 – 4:30. The girls will practice only on Wednesdays from now on until the end of the season. Here are the dates of the remaining practices (all Wednesdays): Jan. 23, Jan. 30, Feb. 6, and Feb. 20 (we are skipping Feb. 16th). The girls will cheer for next Friday's last home game on Feb. 1.

Three of the COL basketball teams traveled to Delano to take on Mt. Olive this past Friday. Here are the results of those games: Girls B won (41 – 9), Boys B lost (10-11), and Girls A won (32 – 8). On Saturday the A teams went to Mankato to compete in the Charger Classic Basketball Tournament. The girls played in the morning and won their first two games, beating Resurrection, Rochester 46 – 4 in the opening game and St. Paul, New Ulm 23 – 19 in the semifinals games. That put them in the championship game against the host school, Mt. Olive, Mankato. It was a great game, but unfortunately COL lost by one point (23 – 24) earning them second place in the tournament. The boys started their tournament play in the afternoon taking on St. Paul, New Ulm in their first game. COL lost that game 18 – 37. They played hard in their second game against Salem, Stillwater taking that game to double overtime. Unfortunately, the boys were unable to come away with the victory, losing 32-29. Yesterday the Girls B team hosted St. Patrick of Hudson in a CAA game matchup. The girls had a great second half, but were unable to overcome the first half deficient, losing 26 – 32.

This week all four teams get back on the road and travel to Salem, Greenfield. It's another long drive so please plan for weather, traffic and any other road conditions. The game times are normal with Girls B starting at 5:30pm, Boys B at 6:30pm, Girls A at 7:30pm and Boys A at 8:30pm. The address of Salem's school is 9615 Pioneer Trail, Loretto, MN 55357.
