This past weekend the A Teams competed in their end of the season Metro League Basketball Tournament. The Boys A started the tournament play Friday night with a win in their first round game against Pilgrim (26-22). They had an hour off and played their second round against Bloomington. COL lost that game 23 – 40. The boys' tournament continued Saturday morning at St. Croix, facing Trinity, Belle Plaine. COL won that game 32 – 19. The boys played again that afternoon against Christ Lutheran. COL was unable to win that game (24 – 53) which ended their tournament play. The Girls A team played their first tournament game Friday night against Mt. Olive and won 40 – 4. They advanced to the semi-final's game at West Lutheran High School on Saturday where they met up with a team that had previously beaten them in the regular season, Salem, Greenfield. COL fought hard and won that game 24 – 18 putting them in the championship game. They faced off against Bloomington, a team that had again previously beaten them in regular season match-up. The girls played hard again and came away champions of the tournament, winning 30 – 24.

Congratulations to the Girls A team for bringing home the championship trophy!

Both teams look forward to getting another chance to compete this weekend at the MLC Invitational Tournament in New Ulm, MN. They will play at Martin Luther College on Friday. The girls will play first that day against St. Martins, Watertown at 12:45pm at MLC. The boys will compete against St. John's, Redwood Falls at 5:45pm, also at MLC. Team pictures will be taken 30 minutes prior to the first games on Friday. Please have your child to MLC in time to change into their uniforms and be ready for the pictures. They will be taken on the stage area in the gym. A packet of information, including player tournament passes will be handed out to the players tomorrow at school. Good luck to our teams on their last tournament of the season!
