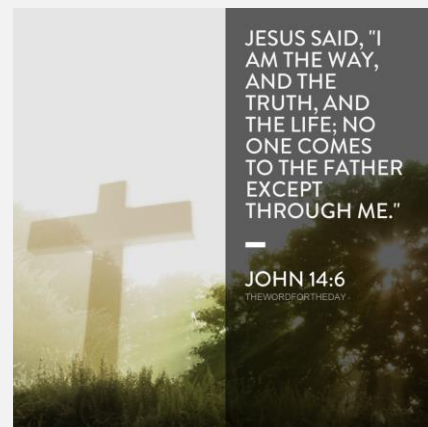

**Junior Raider Basketball:** This Saturday (March 16) will be the fourth and final day of Junior Raider Basketball. Grades 1-2 will be at their normal time of 8 – 9am and grades 3-4 from 9:15 – 10:30am. The shirts have arrived and will be distributed to the players today.

The **Spring Sports Calendar** is being finalized. A hard copy will be sent home by Friday this week; you will also be able view it online after spring break. There may be a couple of changes that need to be made while the season progresses on account of how the weather effects meets or practice days for track. More information is written below.

**Sign-Up Sheet:** In order to give the coaches a better idea of how many athletes to expect for the track and bowling teams, a sign-up sheet has been placed in the lunch room. If your child wishes to participate on either team, remind them to make sure they sign up before Friday. If a student wishes to participate on both the bowling and track teams they may do so. The agreement would be to attend ALL track practices (especially when there is an overlap with bowling on practice days). Fourth graders are invited to participate on the track team – on a limited basis. They would join the team after Easter for two practices and compete in one meet held at St. Croix on Friday May 3.

**Track:** Track practice (grades 5-8) will begin Tuesday, April 2 from 3:30 – 5:00. The first two practices will be held at COL. The plan is to have the remaining practices at St. Croix. However, that is all dependent on the weather and track conditions as the spring thaw begins. Track meets will be on either Wednesday or Thursday with the exception of the Lutheran Metro Grade School Meet held on Friday, May 3 at St. Croix.

**Bowling:** The bowling practices dates are set, but the meet schedule is still being put together. The meets will be on either Fridays or Saturdays. Practices will be every Monday and Tuesday from 3:30-5:00 at Concord Lanes in South St. Paul. Parents are responsible for transporting their child to and from practices. The first practice will start on Monday, March 25.
